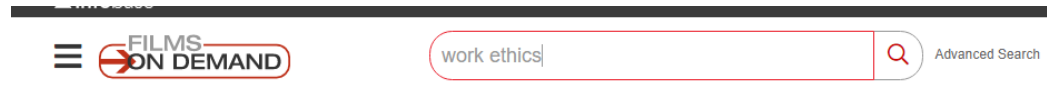

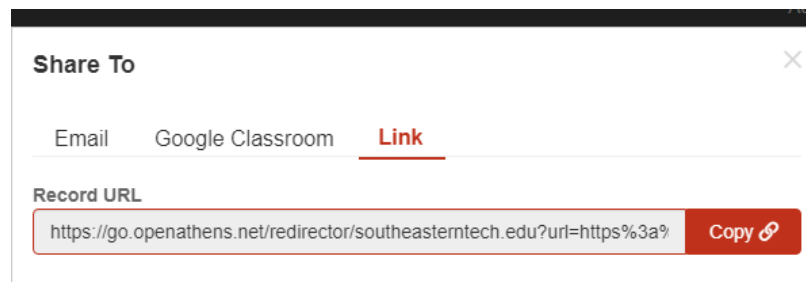

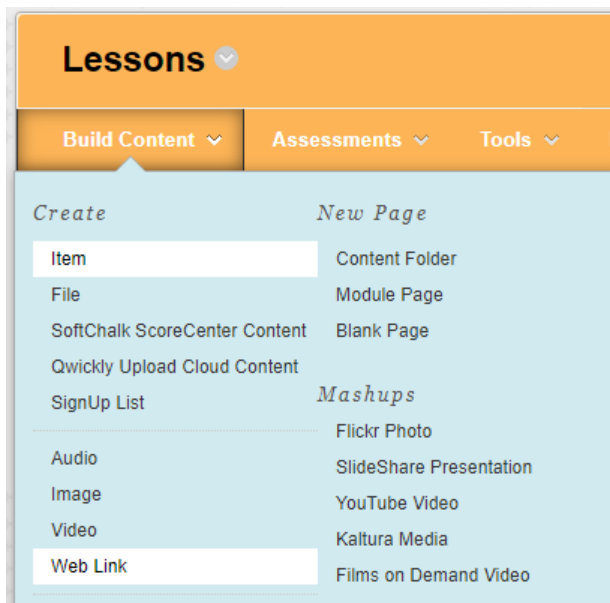

In Blackboard, navigate to the location you want to link the video, click on Build Content, Web Link



The Name and URL are required. Paste the URL you copied from Films on Demand into the URL box.
